

## Pittsworth State School: School Representation Criteria

## Rationale

In order for a student to be eligible to represent the Pittsworth State School community in any capacity, they must be meeting a set criteria and demonstrating a standard of behaviour, effort and attendance which aligns itself with standards from our school community. Representation of the Pittsworth State School community is a privilege. Representation includes –

- All leadership positions
- Any extra-curricular activity including but not limited to sporting teams (representative level or interschool), music (band, eisteddfod or musicals), camps, excursions and graduations or special services.

## **School Criteria for Representation**

The following criteria outlines eligibility for school representation:

- 1. 0-1 Major Behaviour referrals
- 2. 0-5 Minor Behaviour referrals
- 3. At least 90% or higher attendance rate &
- 4. Achieving a "C" or "Satisfactory" for EFFORT in class

## **Notes**

- Eligibility is on a term by term basis only.
- Academic results ARE NOT factored in to the eligibility
- Students who have exceeded any of these criteria will be ineligible to represent Pittsworth State School.
- Remember that three minor behaviours for the same behaviour will be considered a Major behaviour.
- The evidence for student eligibility is determined by data recorded on One School in accordance with Pittsworth State School policy.
